In February, the Department for Science, Innovation, and Technology (DSIT) launched the 'You Won't Know until You Ask' campaign, providing parents with practical support they can use immediately and the confidence they need to have a conversation with their children about the content they see online.

Backed by behavioural research and academic insights, new guidance has been made available to parents on safety settings, conversation prompts, and age-appropriate advice for tackling misinformation and harmful content - including ragebait and misogynistic content.

It comes as a direct response to parents who have been calling out for support on how to navigate their children's use of social media.
